## CIRCULAR

Subject: Change in limits for e-tendering.

Attention is invited to Circular No. 04/ITD of 2015 dated 20.05.2015 issued by the Information Technology Department whereunder Departments have been directed to compulsorily tender all works / procurements costing more than ₹ 1.00 lakh through e-tendering. The required amendments in existing rules on the subject are, however, yet to be carried out since these orders have been issued without the consultation of the Finance Department.

- 2. Pursuant to this circular various Works Departments have issued orders for compulsory e-tendering of works including procurement of stores of value in excess of  $\rat{1,00,000/-}$  ( $\rat{7}$  one lakh only).
- 3. However, it has been found that the executing departments are facing difficulties in the implementation of this downward threshold limit of  $\rat{1.00}$  lakh in their e-tendering process in view of the obtaining conditions in the State, particularly prolonged internet breakdown.
- In the aforesaid context, the decision of the downward limit for e-tendering has been reviewed in the Finance Department and accordingly, the said limit is raised to ₹ 10.00 lakh (₹ ten lakh only). The limit of ₹ 10.00 lakh shall, however, remain in force till such time the ceiling is reviewed by the Finance Department. The Departments shall also ensure against splitting of works to avoid e-tendering as prescribed under these quidelines.
