
**Subject: Potential of procurement.**

Subject: Potential of procurement

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you would be aware, the Union Cabinet approved the setting up of Government e-Marketplace (GeM) as the National Public Procurement Portal for providing procurement of goods & services required by Central & State Government organizations. Triggering the largest transformation exercise in India -- through digitization of processes and a digital integration of all stakeholders, GeM has revolutionized the ecosystem of public procurement in the country for buyers and sellers alike. With multiple procurement modes, inbuilt policies for automated market adjustments and end-to-end digital process to enable a vibrant buyer - seller ecosystem, GeM has drastically brought down waiting times and prices for buyers and ensured timely payments to the sellers. There are more than 46,000 Government organizations and over 6.02 lakh vendors registered on the portal. GeM has over 14.96 lakh products and 146 services. GeM has facilitated transactions for over INR 67,564 crore till date.

2. As per Rule 149 of the Government Financial Rules (GFR), goods and services that are available on GeM should be mandatorily procured through GeM. In order to fully realize the immense advantages accruing in terms of ease of procurement through an open and transparent procurement platform, State Government has executed the MoU with GeM for seamless procurement of Goods and Services required by the State. It has been decided that "there should be a comprehensive study of total procurement of different goods and services by different entities of the government. This can help to identify the potential scope of procurement over GeM and provide a target to be pursued. Performance of specific item-wise action plan for its procurement through GeM can then be measured against this target."

3. With regard to above, it is requested to share the potential of procurement of different goods and services for various departments/organizations/PSUs under the jurisdiction of your State with GeM along with the target of procurement through GeM in the format attached, preferably by 10th November 2020.

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
