

While examining the case files of these incumbents in terms of provisions contained in the Jammu and Kashmir Daily Rated Workers/Work Charged Employees (Regularization) Rules, 1994 notified vide SRO 64/1994 read with Government order No. 26-F of 1994 dated 31.01.1994, the Committee found that the cases are








incomplete and deficiencies as observed are shown against each in the below matrix:-


