**Srinagar, the 20th September, 2014**

**SRO- 383.** In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section 2 of section 3 of the Jammu and Kashmir Entry Tax on Goods Act, 2000, the Government hereby exempts the equipments and spares to be imported by the telecommunication companies into the State for immediate restoration of damaged telecommunication infrastructure caused by the recent floods from levy of entry tax.

The exemption shall, however, be available only for a limited duration viz. from 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2014.

Provided that the goods so imported are accompanied with the certificate from the Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir to the effect that these are exclusively meant for restoration of damaged telecommunication infrastructure.
