Subject: Construction of Government buildings/bridges without approach Roads.

Circular

It has been observed that certain Government buildings, bridges and other establishments are constructed by the executing agencies without approach roads to these projects/bridges etc. Lack of approach roads causes problems to the general public at large and intended outcome of the project is not achieved.

It is as such enjoined upon all the Administrative Secretaries that while sanctioning the projects, integrated approach should be followed. It should be ensured that all the projects to be undertaken for execution having requirement of approach roads shall include the cost of approach roads in the Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) as an integral component and no Technical Sanction/Administrative Approval should be accorded to such buildings/ bridges which do not have the connectivity/approach road incorporated in the project, or any other essential component necessary to achieve intended outcome of the project.
