Whereas, the Finance Department vide communication No. ET/Estt/154/2012 dated 11.08.2015 referred 88 posts of Inspector (State Cadre) (OM=47, RBA=20, SC=08, ST=10, ALC=02, OSC=01) of the J&K Excise and State Taxes (Subordinate) Service to J&K Services Selection Board for selection of suitable candidates; and

2. Whereas, the Jammu & Kashmir Services Selection Board vide communication No.SSB/Secy/Sel/2018/7492-98 dated 27.06.2018 forwarded the select list of 44 candidates for the post of Inspector Finance Department (State Cadre) advertised vide notification No. 05 of 2015 under item No. 169 dated 01.09.2015 indicating therein that recommendation in favour of seven (07) candidates is withheld for various reasons; and

3. Whereas, the Finance Department vide Government Order No. 297-FD of 2018 dated 03-07-2018 issued appointment order in favour of 37 candidates; and

4. Whereas, the JKSSB later released recommendations in favour of six (06) more candidates and the Finance Department vide Government Order No. 383-FD of 2018 dated 07.09.2018, Government Order No. 499-FD of 2018 dated 22.11.2018 and Government Order No. 68-FD of 2018 dated 29.01.2019 issued appointment orders in favour of these 06 candidates; and

5. Whereas, the JKSSB vide Communication No. 16-SSB of 2019 dated 09.01.2019 forwarded the select list of remaining 44 candidates for the post of Inspector Finance Department (State Cadre), indicating therein that the recommendations in favour of seven (07) candidates is withheld due to various reason, and the Finance Department vide



Government Order No. 70-FD of 2019 dated 29-01-2019 issued appointment orders in favour of 37 candidates; and

6. Whereas, the JKSSB vide communications dated 24.01.2019, 05.03.2019, 15.03.2019 and 04.12.2019 further released recommendations in favour of five (5) candidates and the Finance Department vide Government Order No. 100- FD of 2019 dated 08.02.2019 and Government Order No. 358-FD of 2019 dated 29-05-2019 issued appointment orders in their favour; and

7. Whereas, the JKSSB vide Order No. 291-SSB of 2019 dated 04.12.2019 cancelled the candidature of Mr. Akash Koul S/o Rattan Lal figuring at S.No. 10/RBA whose recommendation was kept withheld for want of certain clarification of documents and the Finance Department vide Government Order No. 02-FD of 2020 dated 03.01.2020 issued appointment order in favour of the candidate figuring next in order of merit by operating the waiting list; and

8. Whereas, one (01) post of Inspector at S.No 17 in the select list under RBA category was kept reserved by JKSSB in light of Hon'ble Court Order dated 28.12.2015 passed in SWP No. 2130/2015, MP No. 1/2015 and MP No. 1/2015 and MP No. 02/2015; and

9. Whereas, upon dismissal of writ petition SWP No. 2130/2015 by the Hon'ble Court, JKSSB vide Office Order No. 311-SSB of 2019 dated 24.12.2019 defroze the said post and, Finance Department vide Government Order No. 11-FD of 2020 dated 08.01.2020 issued appointment order in favour of the eligible candidate against the post available for selection at S.No. 17 in the select list of RBA category; and

10. Whereas, the JKSSB, which has withheld the recommendation of Mr. Naresh Singh figuring at S.No. 27 OM/ESM category for want of some clarification in respect of his documents has now vide communication No. SSB/Secy/Sel/2018/383-85 dated 15.01.2020 released recommendation in his favour; and

11. Now, therefore, as recommended by the J&K Services Selection Board, sanction is hereby accorded to the temporary appointment of Naresh Singh S/o Prem Chand R/o Dewal Billawar



Kathua Inspector (State Cadre) in the pay Level-6 (35400-112400) figuring at (S.No. 27/OM/ESM category) in the J&K Excise and State Taxes (Subordinate) Service with immediate effect with the directions to report to **State Taxes Department**, J&K within a period of twenty one (21) days from the date of issuance of this order; and

12. The appointment of the above said candidate shall be subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- A) The appointment including pay, service etc shall be governed in terms of J&K Special Recruitment Rules, 2015 [SRO-202 dated 30-06-2015].
- B) The appointee shall be allowed to join only on production of the following certificates in original:-
 - 1. Academic/Technical Qualification Certificates.
 - 2. Matriculation/Date of Birth Certificate.
 - 3. Health Certificate issued by Chief Medical Officer.
 - 4. Permanent Resident Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
 - 5. Certificates from the District Industries Centre (DIC) and District Employment & Counseling Centre to the effect that no loan under the self-employment scheme has been taken by the appointee.
 - 6. Reserved Category Certificate (in case of candidates belonging to reserved category).
- C) The appointment of the candidate as Inspector shall further be subject to the following conditions:-
 - i. The appointee shall give an undertaking duly attested by the First Class Magistrate in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that in case adverse report about his character and antecedents is received from Inspector General of Police, (CID), J&K to whom a reference shall be made by the concerned HoD, the candidate shall have no right to claim his appointment as Inspector and his appointment as such shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio.
 - ii. If on verification, the certificate(s) produced by the appointee are proved to be fake or forged, the appointment shall be cancelled ab-initio.
 - iii. The salary of the appointee shall not be drawn and disbursed to him unless the satisfactory reports in respect of (i) and (ii) above are received in his favour.
 - iv. The appointee shall be on probation for a period of 05 years and shall undergo and qualify the requisite Departmental Examination within the period of probation.
 - v. The inter-se-seniority of the appointee shall be strictly as per the merit in the select list.



- D) If the candidate fails to join within a period of 21 (twenty one) days from the date of issuance of the appointment order, he shall forego his right to appointment which shall be deemed to have been cancelled abinitio without any further notice.


