Whereas, the Finance Department vide communication No. ET/Estt/154/2012 dated 11.08.2015 referred ninety three (93) posts (OM=49, RBA=21, SC=09, ST=10, OSC=01 & ALC=03) of Sub-Inspector (Divisional Cadre Kashmir) of the J&K Excise and State Taxes (Subordinate) Service to J&K Services Selection Board for selection of suitable candidates; and

2. Whereas, the Jammu & Kashmir Services Selection Board vide No. SSB/Secy/Sel/2019/148-54 dated 08.01.2019 forwarded select list of ninety three (93) candidates for the post of Sub-Inspector, Divisional Cadre Kashmir indicating therein that the recommendations in favour of eight (08) candidates is withheld for want of certain clarifications; and

3. Whereas, the Finance Department vide Government Order No. 42-FD of 2019 dated 22.01.2019 issued appointment orders in favour of eighty five (85) Sub-Inspectors of Divisional Cadre Kashmir; and

4. Whereas, the Jammu & Kashmir Services Selection Board vide different communications subsequently from time to time released the recommendations in favour of 07 candidates and Finance Department vide Government Order 94-FD of 2019 dated 07.02.2019 and G.O. No 342-FD of 24.04.2019 issued appointment orders in their favour; and

5. Whereas, the Finance Department later operated the waiting list and vide Government Order No.369-FD of 2019 dated 26.06.2019 cancelled the appointment of thirty five (35) candidates who did not join and issued appointment Order of twenty eight candidates vide Government Order No. 370-FD of 2019 dated 20.06.2019; and

6. Whereas, the J&K Services Selection Board withheld the recommendation in favour of Mehraj-U-Din Khan figuring at S.No. 14/OM-Waiting for want of some clarification in respect of his documents; and

7. Whereas, the J&K Services Selection Board vide No. SSB/Secy/Sel/18/2019/280-82 dated 14.01.2020 has now released the recommendation in favour of Mehraj-U-Din Khan figuring at S.No. 14/OM-Waiting as per the terms and conditions already conveyed vide office letter No. SSB/Secy/Sel/2019/148-54 dated 8.01.2019; and

B. Now, as recommended by the J&K Services Selection Board, sanction is hereby accorded to the temporary appointment of Mr. Mehraj-U-Din Khan S/o Nazir Ahmad Khan R/o Kulangam Handwara (S.No. 14-Waiting/OM category) as Sub-Inspector (Divisional Cadre Kashmir) in the Pay Level-4 (25500-81100) in the J&K Excise and State Taxes (Subordinate) Service as per the terms and conditions conveyed by Service Selection Board vide letter NO. SSB/Secy/Sel/2019/148-54 dated 08.01.2019 with the directions to report to State Taxes Department, J&K within a period of twenty one (21) days from the date of issuance of this order.

9. The appointment of the above said candidate shall be subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- A) The appointment including pay, service etc shall be governed in terms of J&K Special Recruitment Rules, 2015 (SRO-202 dated 30-06-2015).
- B) The appointee shall be allowed to join only on production of the following certificates in original:-
 1. Academic/Technical Qualification Certificates.
 2. Matriculation/Date of Birth Certificate
 3. Health Certificate issued by Chief Medical Officer.
 4. Certificates from the District Industries Centre (DIC) and District Employment & Counselling Centre to the effect that no loan under the self-employment scheme has been taken by the appointee
 5. Permanent Resident Certificate.


6. Reserved Category Certificate/disability certificate (in case of candidates belonging to reserved category)

C) The appointment of the candidate as Sub-Inspector shall further be subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The appointee shall give an undertaking duly attested by the First Class Magistrate in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that in case adverse report about his character and antecedents is received from Inspector General of Police, (CID), J&K to whom a reference shall be made by the concerned HoD, the candidate shall have no right to claim his appointment as Sub Inspector and his appointment as such shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio.
- ii. If on verification, the certificate(s) produced by the appointee are proved to be fake or forged, the appointment shall be cancelled ab-initio.
- iii. The salary of the appointee shall not be drawn and disbursed to him unless the satisfactory reports in respect of (i) and (ii) above are received in his favour.
- iv. The appointee shall be on probation for a period of 05 years and shall undergo and qualify the Departmental Examination (Excise and Taxation Part-1 Examination) within the period of probation.
- v. The inter-se-seniority of the appointee shall be strictly as per his merit in the select list.

D) The candidate who fail to join within a period of 21 (twenty one) days from the date of issuance of the appointment order shall forego their right to appointment which shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio without any further notice.
