 - Matriculation/Date of Birth Certificate. ii. iii.
 - Health Certificate from the concerned Chief Medical Officer of the District. ίv.
 - Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
 - Valid relevant Category Certificate.

 - a.
