Subject :—J&K Civil Service (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992, Notification SRO-75 dated 30-3-1992—Application thereof in respect of leave arrangements/ad hoc appointees.

Attention is invited to the J & K Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992 issued vide Notification SRO-75 dated 30-3-1992. A doubt has been expressed about the application of these rules to persons engaged against leave arrangements and to persons who may have been engaged on short term basis including those appointed on ad hoc basis after 1st April, 1990.

The issue has been examined in the Finance Department and it is clarified that the provisions of the J & K Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992, issued vide Notification SRO-75 dated 30-3-1992, will also apply in the case of the persons appointed on leave arrangement basis as also to the persons appointed on ad hoc basis (with or without break) for a limited period after 1st April, 1990.

The Administrative Departments are requested to kindly communicate the above instructions to all the Officers/Organisations under them.

Subject :—Revision of Pay Scales for Public Sector Undertakings.

Reference :—Administrative Council Decision No. 71 dated 20-5-1992.

Government Order No. 39-F of 1992

Dated 28-5-1992.

In supersession of Government Order No. 339-F of 1992 dated 31-3-1992 and hoping that the employees of the Public Sector Undertakings will return this gesture of the Government by devoting themselves with greater vigour to raising output and income of the Undertakings it is hereby ordered that :—

1. (a) In respect of the employees of Jammu and Kashmir Public Sector Undertakings as are governed by Wage Committee Report (Rajan Committee), the revised pay scales, as shown in Annexure to this order be adopted with effect from 1-9-1990.
- (b) To arrive at the initial pay to be fixed in the revised pay scales as on 1-9-1990 in respect of those employees who were in service as on 1-9-1987, the said date (1-9-1987) shall be taken into account for purpose of fixation of pay notionally in the revised scales.
- (c) The initial pay as per sub-para (b) above shall be fixed, notionally, as on 1-9-1987, as under :—
If the basic pay in the "existing pay scale" as on 1-9-1987 :—
(i) is less than the minimum of the revised pay scale the pay shall be fixed at that minimum ;
(ii) coincide with a stage in the revised pay scale, the pay shall be fixed at that stage ;
(iii) falls between the two stages in the revised pay scale, the pay shall be fixed at the next stage ;
- (d) To the initial pay thus notionally fixed as per sub-para (c) above shall be added, notionally, such number of increments in the revised pay scale as were availed of by him or were due to him in the existing pay scale to arrive at his basic pay in the revised scale as on 1-9-1990.
2. (a) An employee may, however, elect to opt for a date later than 1-9-1987 but up to 31-8-1990 for fixation of his pay notionally in the revised pay scale, in which case the

provision of sub-para (b), (c) and (d) of para 1 above shall apply to him from such date of option.

- (b) An employee may opt for a date later than 31-8-1990 for fixation of pay in the revised pay scale, in which case the provision of sub-para (c) of para 1 shall apply to him from such date of option.
- (c) An employee who may have opted to retain the pre-1-9-1987 pay scale up to a specified date, shall have the right to exercise a fresh option for electing a date for fixation of his pay in the revised pay scale.
3. (a) In the case of an employee appointed on or after 1-9-1987 but before 1-9-1990 the provisions of para 1 above shall apply from such date of appointment instead of 1-9-1987.
- (b) An employee who has joined service on or after 1-9-1990 shall be deemed to have been appointed directly in the corresponding revised pay scale.
4. The next date of increment of an employee whose pay has been fixed in the revised pay scale in accordance with the above provisions shall be granted on the date he would have drawn his increment had he continued in the existing scale:

Provided that in case of an employee who has been drawing the maximum of the "existing pay scale" as on 1-9-1990 the date of next increment shall be after putting in one full incremental period from the date of fixation of initial pay in the revised pay scale.

5. In respect of "Exercise of Option", "Crossing of Qualification/Efficiency Bars", "Creation of new Posts" the provisions of rules (7), (10), (11) and (15) of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992 shall apply mutatis mutandis, for purposes of this order.

Note :—The term "existing pay scale" used in this order shall mean the pay scales prescribed vide Government Order No. 296-F of 1987 dated 13-10-1987.

Subject :—Adjustment of L. T. C. Claims.

The J&K Civil Services (LTC) Rules, 1990 have been ordered to remain in-operative for a period of six months vide Notification SRO-53 dated 13-3-1992 read with Notification SRO-138 dated 10-6-1992. Doubts have been expressed about the settlement of LTC claims for the period prior to 13-3-1992 and clarifications sought from Finance Department accordingly.

The matter has been examined and accordingly it is clarified that all cases where sanctions (with or without advances) for availing of LTC were issued and outward journey commenced on or before 13-3-1992, shall not be affected by the aforementioned Notifications SRO-53 dated 13-3-1992 and SRO-138 dated 10-6-1992. Such cases shall be settled by the concerned Departments as per the provisions contained in J&K Civil Services (LTC) Rules, 1990.

Nothing contained in this circular is, however, intended to condone any irregularity or violation of any provision of the J&K Civil Service (LTC) Rules, 1990. However, where a claim of aforementioned nature, which has been presented within the prescribed time limit after completion of the inward journey has not so far has been entertained, for want of these clarification should now be entertained, provided all the other conditions laid down in the rules are fulfilled.

Subject :—Accounting procedure for deductions on account of G. P. Fund, SLI etc. from Migrant Government Employees.

The undersigned is directed to invite attention to Government Order No 637-GR of 1990 dated 5-6-1990 read with Government Order No. 742-G^R (GAD) of 1990 dated 16-7-1990 where under the migrant Government employees were allowed to draw net salary which they were in receipt of immediately before their migration from the Valley. The net salary thus paid to the migrant Government employees was to be treated as an on account payment to be adjusted subsequently by the office to which they originally belonged in the Valley. Accordingly the Drawing and Disbursing Officers in Jammu and elsewhere have been disbursing net salary to the migrant employees without adjustment of the amount thus withheld from their salary on account of G. P. Fund subscriptions, SLI premia, House Building Advance instalment etc. etc. with a view to accounting for these deductions so far made or to be made in future from the salary of the migrant Government employees, the Drawing and Disbursing Officers, who draw/disburse the migrant salary of these migrant employees are instructed to follow the following procedure :—

- (a) The Drawing and Disbursing Officers drawing migrant salary of the migrant Government employees shall send a list of the migrant employees drawing salary from their offices to the Chief Accounts Officer, District Fund Office (Migrant Cell), Jammu for allotment of fresh G. P. Fund Account Numbers. The said list will also indicate inter alia the original G. P. Fund Account Number of the respective District Fund Office in the Valley. In cases where the original Account Number is not available with the migrant employee, the list will indicate the District Fund Office in which the G. P. Fund Account of the employee was mentioned in the Valley. Fresh declaration forms may also be obtained from the migrant employees and appended to the said list.
- (b) A similar list of migrant employees together with the SLI Policy numbers be sent to the Accounts Officer, State Life Insurance Fund, Kachi Chawni, Jammu. In case where SLI Policy number is not available with a migrant employee, the percentage of the Insurant and other particulars be indicated in the list.
- (c) The Drawing and Disbursing Officers drawing migrant salary will prepare adjustment bills for the entire

period of migration, abinitio, supported by relevant deduction Schedules on account of G. P. Fund, SLI, House Building Advance etc. etc. giving reference to Treasury Voucher Number and date vide which the monthly salary bills have been drawn. This will be done in anticipation of receipt of fresh G. P. Fund Account Numbers from the Chief Accounts Officer, District Fund Office (Migrant Cell), Jammu.

- (d) The deduction schedules on account of G. P. Fund deductions will, for the time being (pending receipt of fresh Account numbers from District Fund Office, Jammu) indicate the G. P. Fund Account number of the respective District Fund Offices in the Valley. In case where G. P. Fund Account number is not available with the migrant employees the deduction schedule may indicate the name and designation of the employees and the District Fund Office in which his G. P. Fund Account was maintained in the Valley. The said deduction schedules will be sent by the respective Treasury Officers to the Chief Account Officer, District Fund Office (Migrant Cell) Jammu, who will proceed further to allot fresh G. P. Fund Account numbers to all the migrant employees on the basis of the list already received by him from the respective Drawing and Disbursing Officers, as per (a) above. For the future the fresh G. P. Fund Account numbers will be indicated in the monthly schedules over the old G. P. Fund Account number, if available.
- (e) In the case of SLI Premia, the deductions schedule will indicate the policy number and in cases where a policy number is not available, the schedule will indicate the percentage of the Insurant along with his name. The said deduction schedule on account of SLI will be sent by the respective Treasury Officers to the Accounts Officer, Insurance, Jammu who will proceed further to account for the deduction on account of SLI Premia and in cases where policy number is not indicated in the schedule, obtain the same from the Accounts Officer Insurance, Srinagar.
- (f) A similar procedure as indicated in (d) and (e) above will be *mutatis mutandis mutandis*, in respect of other deductions. In respect of deductions on account of House Building Advance, Scooter/Car Advances etc. The deduction schedules will be sent by Treasury Officers concerned to the Accountant General, Jammu or Srinagar, as the case may be.
- (g) All the deduction schedules mentioned above shall be superscribed with the word "MIGRANTS" in block letters, and in red ink.

(h) The deductions made on account to G. P. Fund in respect of the salary for the entire period of migration, by adjustment as per (c) above shall be deemed to have been made on the first day of the month following the month to which the salary pertained for purpose of calculations of interest of the G. P. Fund accumulations. The same principle shall apply in the case of SLI Premia and other deductions relating to interest bearing advances etc.
