Subject:—Minutes of the meeting of the Committee on Pensioners Affairs held on 23-4-1992 at 3 P. M.—Decision taken.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the decisions taken in the meeting of the Committee on Pensioners Affairs held on 23rd April, 1992 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary as per the minutes thereof issued vide Finance Department endorsement No. A/25 (87)-III/328 dated 26th May, 1992 (copy enclosed for ready reference). Among other things, it has been decided in the said meeting that the minimum pension/family pension be raised from Rs. 325/- to Rs. 375/- in respect of the existing pensioners (pre 1st April, 1992 Pensioners) in terms of SRO-77 dated 30th March, 1992, by the Treasury Officers themselves without requiring a fresh authority from the Accountant General.

It may be recalled that the minimum pension/family pension has been raised to Rs. 375/- P. M. w. e. f. 1st April, 1992 in respect of all the existing pensioners including family pensioners (pre 1st April, 1992 Pensioners) vide Notification SRO-77 dated 30th March, 1992. Accordingly all the pensioners/family pensioners drawing pension/family pension of less than Rs. 375/- shall be entitled to draw Rs. 375/- P. M. w. e. f. 1st April, 1992. No fresh authorisation from the Accountant General for the purpose shall be required for this purpose. All the Treasury Officers should therefore besides taking necessary action in respect of the pensioners/family pensioners drawing pension/family pension directly from the treasuries inform the concerned branches of the J&K Bank wherefrom the pensioners/family pensioners draw their pension/family pension about the enhancement of the basic pension/family pension to Rs. 375/- P. M. in respect of the said pensioners/family pensioners.

Subject :—Fictitious circular O. M. No. A/2 (92)-VIII/1209 dated 14th September, 1992 regarding provisions of initial higher starting/advance increments for higher qualification contained in the J&K Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992 issued vide Notification SRO-75 dated 30th March, 1992.

It has come to the notice of the Finance Department that someone has clandestinely issued a fictitious circular under a fake O. M. No. A/2 (92)-VIII/1209 dated 14th September, 1992 having fraudulently been shown as signed by Director (Codes), Finance Department. Under the said fictitious circular O. M. the following fraudulently manipulated "Instructions" have been issued :—

"A doubt has been expressed about the date from which the provisions contained in rules 8 and 9 of SRO-75 dated 30th March, 1992, in allowing higher starting salary and special treatments for certain posts in respect of fresh recruits/ new appointments shall remain in-operative.

The matter has been examined in the Finance Department and it is clarified that the provisions of SRO-75 in to along with other benefits like higher starting salary and higher scale which are/were attached with certain categories of posts heretofore shall continue to remain in force in respect of all Government servants who were in service on 1st April, 1987 or appointed thereafter up to 30th March, 1992.

However, all fresh recruits made from 31st March, 1992 onwards will strictly be governed under the standard provision of SRO-75 dated 30th March, 1992.

All the Heads of Departments are requested to kindly communicate the above instructions to all the offices/ organisations under them".

It may be notified for information of all the Departments and offices/organisations/units under each Department that no such Circular O. M. No. A/2 (92)-VIII/1209 dated 14th September, 1992 has ever been issued by the Finance Department. Whereas the Finance Department have taken up the matter with Home Department (Crime Branch) to investigate into the matter expeditiously and bring the culprit (s) to book, in the meantime

no cognizance of the said fake and fraudulently manipulated circular O. M. should be taken by any Department/Office/ Institutions/Organisation of the Government. In the event of any payment having already been made by any Drawing and Disbursing Officer on the basis of the said fake circular O. M. the same should be recovered forthwith in one lump.

The respective controlling officers and the Heads of Departments shall be personally responsible to ensure that these instructions are adhered to strictly.

Pension

Subject :—Revision of Pension cases under SRO-75 dated 30-3-1992 effective from 1-4-1990.

Following doubts have been expressed about the application of J&K Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992 issued vide Notification SRO-75 dated 30-3-1992 in respect of retired Government servants :—

- (a) Whether pension has to be refixed in respect of Government employees who have retired between 1-4-1987 and 31-3-1990.
- (b) What procedure has to be adopted for determining the "Emoluments" for last 10 months of service where date of retirement falls after 30-4-1990 and certain period of the requisite ten months also falls before 1-4-1990.
- (c) What procedure has to be adopted for arriving at the "Assumed Pay" in respect of such a Government servant who has retired voluntarily (under Article 230 of J&K Civil Service Regulations) between 1-4-1987 and 31-3-1990.

The above doubts have been examined in the Finance Department and are clarified as under :—

- (a) The pay revision has taken place effectively from 1-4-1990. The date of 1-4-1987 which is relevant only for arriving at the initial pay in the revised Pay Scale as on 1-4-1990, has therefore, to be ignored for purposes of retirement benefits. Refixation of pension or any other retirement benefits in consequence of J&K Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992 is not therefore involved in respect of those who have retired between 1-4-1987 and 31-3-1990.
- (b) The pension has to be worked out on the basis of 10 months average "Emoluments" as defined for the purpose of pension under rules and as such "Emoluments" actually drawn (and not notionally arrived at) during the two spells of pre 1-4-1990 and post 1-4-1990 periods have to be taken into account.
- (c) The pension is to be worked out on the "assumed pay" which the concerned would have drawn in the pay scale actually held by him at the time of his retirement

on retiring (voluntary) pension. The benefit of revised pay scale will not accrue in such cases.

Whereas the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992 have been issued by the Government vide Notification SRO-75 dated 30-3-1992; and

Whereas as per the provisions of these rules, the initial fixation of pay as on 1-4-1992, in the revised pay scales has to be done after taking into account the date of 1-4-1987 for purpose of such fixation; and

Whereas a few batches of Degree Holders were appointed as Junior Engineers Grade II in various Departments under PWD, PDD etc. in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 1300-2550 in and around March, 1988, in pursuance of the Re-organisation Scheme of the Engineering Departments whereunder, *inter-alia*, the posts of Junior Engineers (Grade-II) were created, to which the Degree Holders (Engineers) also were made eligible for recruitment; and

Whereas, as per the rules then in force, the said Junior Engineers (Degree Holders) and such of them appointed after March, 1988 but before 30-3-1992 (that is the date of issue of Notification SRO-75 dated 30-3-1992) were allowed a higher start of Rs. 1620/- in the said pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 1300-2550, in lieu of their higher qualification; and

Whereas under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992, the initial pay of the said Junior Engineers (Degree Holders) in the corresponding revised pay scale of Rs. 1760-3200 was fixed at Rs. 1760/- being the minimum of the revised pay scale of Rs. 1760-3200; and

Whereas, in the said manner, these Junior Engineers (Degree Holders) felt aggrieved because of having been discriminated in relation to those employees the minimum of whose pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 1550-2550 had been revised to Rs. 2000/- in the revised pay scale of Rs. 2000-3200; and

Whereas the issue has been examined by the Government and it has been found that the grievance of the said Junior Engineers (Degree Holders) is genuine to the extent that their

initial pay in the corresponding revised pay scale of Rs. 1760-3200 has been fixed at Rs. 1760/-, while the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 1550-2550 have moved to Rs. 2000-3200.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred vide rule 17 of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992, it is hereby ordered that the minimum pay of Junior Engineers (Degree Holders) (appointed after 1-4-1987 but before 30-3-1992 in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 1300-40-1620-EB-50-2070-EB-60-2550 and allowed a higher start of Rs. 1620/- therein) shall be re-fixed at Rs. 2000/- in the corresponding revised pay scale of Rs. 1760-60-2600-EB-75-3200 with effect from the respective dates of their appointment inserted vide Addendum No. A/2(92)-III/824 dated 13-11-92 subject to fulfilment of all the conditions laid down in Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1992.

In no case, an attested true/photostat copy of a financial sanction can be acted upon by an officer of the Government.

The undersigned is accordingly directed to reiterate the aforementioned basic principle and to impress upon all the officers in the Government not to act upon an attested true/ photo-stat copy of a Government Order, or a Government Notification, a Government Circular Letter O. M. or any other Government communication, issued by a duly authorised Officer, and, instead, take action only on the communications either directly endorsed by the issuing authority to the officer required to take action thereon or on a copy thereof endorsed through a second endorsement, by the officer to whom the original communication may have been endorsed by the issuing authority.
