

5. It has been noticed that there is hiatus in issuance of formal orders by the Administrative Departments/Heads of Departments as per the approval conveyed by the Committee. We can understand that some inherent time lag is inevitable in the very procedure of verification of bio-data as well as the conduct of the concerned for issuance of formal orders of appointment but then in some cases the delay has been inordinate. It is therefore, enjoined upon all the Additional Chief Secretaries/Commr./Secretaries to Govt. that orders should be issued expeditiously to avoid inordinate delays.

6. It is also likely that Departments had taken follow up action on the approval accorded by the Committee but in absence of any endorsement of orders to us in the Finance Department and particularly to the Director (Codes) Finance Department, (Member Secretary to the Committee) we do not have accurate position of the orders issued by the Departments. We would expect a report from all the Departments, in whose case the clearance has been given so that we update the records.

7. We are proceeding on the basis that all the Departments having daily rated workers/work charged employees, who are eligible for coverage under the dispensation provided by the State Government have sent the statement to Finance Department and there are no Departments/Organisations other than those as indicated in the statement enclosed. It is also for the information that no case for the year 1994-95 would be entertained by the Committee after 31st March 1995, as it shall be presumed that all the eligible cases have been processed and dealt with. It is because the exercise for the year 1995-96 is to commence from April, 1995.

In view of above, all Additional Chief Secretaries/Commissioners/Secretaries/Heads of Departments/Chief Executives of Public Sector Undertakings are requested to ensure that where clearance/approval for creation of posts has been conveyed by the Committee orders for regularisation should be immediately issued under intimation to the Finance Department in the prescribed manner. In all such cases where the proposals have not been prepared the process should culminate before March 1995. In other cases where certain incompletions have been indicated by the Finance Department, the same may be examined and fresh proposals as per the prescribed statement submitted to the Finance Department for consideration and notification of the schedule of discussions.

The matter may be treated as post urgent.

Subject : Implementation of relief package of Interim Relief and Medical Allowance in favour of the employees/workers of Public Sector Undertakings of the State.

Reference : State Administrative Council Decision No. 24 dated 6-3-1995.

Following the grant of Interim Relief of Rs. 100/- per month in favour of the State Government employees with effect from 1st August, 1994 and enhancement of Medical Allowance from Rs. 50/- to Rs. 80/- per month in their favour with effect from 1st January, 1995, the employees of State Public Sector Undertakings also demanded the increase in the Medical Allowance and grant of Interim Relief on the analogy of the concession granted in favour of the State Government Employees.

2. On examination of the matter in detail the proposal for grant of Interim Relief of Rs. 100/- with effect from 1st August, 1994 and enhancement of Medical Allowance from Rs. 50/- to Rs. 80/- with effect from 1-1-1995 in favour of the employees/workers of State Public Sector undertakings was considered by the State Administrative Council in its meeting on 6-3-1995 and following decision was taken :-

"Proposal was approved in principle, subject, however, to consideration and decision by the Board of Directors of such Unit having regard to its resources and productivity."

3. Undersigned is accordingly directed to convey the aforementioned decision of the Administrative Council to enable each Organisation to take decision for grant of Interim Relief and enhancement of Medical Allowance to its employees/workers at par with that of State Government employees in respective Board of Directors, having due regard to the financial position, their capacity to meet the expenses from internal resources or for prescription of any such conditionalities which can induce improvement in the productivity levels. Action is requested to be taken accordingly.

The following shall be inserted as a Note below Article 77-B (preceding the Government Instruction No. 1 thereunder) :-

Note--

- (a) in case the minimum of the upgraded pay scale is higher than the pay drawn in the existing pay scale, the pay be fixed at that minimum ;
- (b) in case the pay drawn in the existing pay scale coincides with the stage of pay in the upgraded pay scale, the pay be fixed at the same stage ;
- (c) in case the pay in the existing scale is drawn at a stage falling between the two stages of the pay in the upgraded pay scale, the pay be fixed at the next higher stage ;
- (d) the date of increment in all the above three cases shall remain unchanged except where the pay in the pre-upgraded scale was drawn at the maximum thereof. In the latter case next increment in the pay scale of the upgraded post shall be drawn after the full incremental period (one year) reckoning from the date of up-gradation.

For this purpose the MOUs between the Administrative Departments concerned and Public Sector Undertakings will be drawn up providing for suitable physical and financial targets. Such MOUs be executed in April itself, and thereafter the results achieved will be monitored every month. B. P.E. will closely monitor the performance of all Public Sector Undertakings and submit a report for information of State Administrative Council from time to time ; and
- (iii) Arrears on account of auditing of accounts in respect of Public Sector Undertakings would also be closely monitored by the concerned departments with a view to expeditiously clearing these. B.P.E. will submit a status note in this regard to the State Administrative Council.

Due to various reasons these rules were ordered to remain inoperative for a period of three months vide notification SRO 53 dated 13-3-1992. This period was subsequently extended from time to time through various notifications, last in the series being SRO-200 dated 22-9--1994, according to which the L.T.C. Rules continued to remain inoperative up to 1st March, 1995.

The issue regarding revival of LTC is being examined by the Government. It has been found that there is much scope in revising the various provisions in the existing in-operative rules. Accordingly the rules are being streamlined and till further orders the existing rules shall continue to remain inoperative.

In partial modification of Government Order No. 191-F of 1994 dated 29-11-1994, it is hereby ordered that all Government employees including Work Charged and Whole Time contingent paid employees working in the regular time scale of pay shall be paid Dearness Allowance at the following rates with effect from 1-1-1995 :-

Pay Range	Rate of Dearness Allowance (Including previous instalments) per month w.e.f. 1-1-1995
(i) Basic pay upto Rs. 3,500/-	125% of "basis pay"
(ii) Basic pay above Rs. 3,500 but below Rs. 6,000/- p.m.	94% of basic pay subject to minimum of Rs. 4375/- p.m.
(iii) Basic Pay above Rs. 6,000/- p.m.	81% of basis pay subject to minimum of Rs. 5,640/- p.m.

2. The additional instalment of Dearness Allowance shall be paid in cash w.e.f. 1-1-1995 to all categories of employees including those drawing pay above Rs. 3500/- p.m.

3. The basic pay for the purpose of this order shall be the basic pay as defined in Art. 27(a) (i) of J&K Civil Service Regulations plus the stagnation personal pay which has been allowed to be treated as part of pay for Dearness Allowance as per Government Order No. 226-GR/F of 1990 dated 31-10-1990.

4. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving a fraction of 50 paise and above shall be rounded to the next higher rupee and the fraction of less than 50 paise shall be ignored.

5. The provisions of this order shall also apply mutatis mutandis in the case of All India Service Officers serving in connection with the affairs of the State.

Revised Rates w.e.f. 1-1-1995.

Government Order 100-F of 1995.

Dated 18-4-1995.

In partial modification of Government Order No. 192-F of 1994 dated 29-11-1994, it is hereby ordered that the Government Pensioners and Family Pensioners shall be allowed Dearness Allowance on Pension/Family Pension at the following rates with effect from 1-1-1995 :-

Pension/Family Pension per month	Rates of Dearness Allowance per month (Including previous instalments) w.e.f. 1-1-1995
(i) Basic pay upto Rs. 1,750/-	125% of Pension/Family Pension.
(ii) Basic pay above Rs. 1750/- but not exceeding Rs. 3,000/-	94% of Pension/Family Pension subject to minimum of Rs. 2,188/-
(iii) Exceeding Rs. 3,000/-	81% of Pension/Family Pension subject to minimum of Rs. 2,820/-

2. Pension/Family Pension in the case of pre 01-04-1987 retirees and where family pension was sanctioned prior to 1-4-1987 means the consolidated pension or consolidated family pension as the case may be effective from 1-4-1987 in terms of Government Order No 93-F of 1988 dated 1-4-1988.

3. In the case of Pensioners who have retired from service on or after 1-4-1987 and in the case of family pensioners whose family pension has been sanctioned for the first time on or after 1-4-1987 pension/family pension shall mean basic pension/family pension admissible in terms of Notification SRO 129 dated 5-4-1988.

4. In the case of family pensioners whose family pension is sanctioned in respect of a Government servant who has retired or may retire on or after 1-4-1992 and has died or may die thereafter or who has died or may die while in service on or after his said date, the family pension shall mean the basic pension as admissible in terms of Rule 20 (B) of Family Pension Rules (Schedule XV) of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations incorporated vide notification SRO-77 dated 30-3-1992.

5. Payment of Dearness Allowance involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded to the next rupee.

6. Personal Pension, if any will not be taken into account for determining Dearness Allowance on pension.

7. Other provisions governing grant of Dearness Allowance on Pension/Family Pension such as regulation of Dearness Allowance during employment/re-employment, regulation of Dearness Allowance where more than one pension is drawn etc. and other provisions of the existing rules, orders (as are not in conflict to the provisions of this order) shall continue to remain in force.

8. The Treasury Officers and/or the paying Branches of the Jammu and Kashmir Bank where from the State Pensioners/Family Pensioners draw their pension shall authorise payment of Dearness Allowance to the Pensioners without waiting for any further instructions either from the Accountant General or from the General Manager, Jammu and Kashmir Bank. Where the Bank feels any doubt in the computation of Dearness Allowance in any case they shall refer the matter to the concerned Treasury Officer for clarification.
