SRO-191.—In exercise of the powers conferred under proviso to section 124 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir, the Governor is pleased to direct that the following amendments shall be made in Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service (Revised Pay) Rules, 1998.

In the said rules, following shall be inserted as Note-3 below Rule 15-e :—

Note 3.—All the posts of following categories of Headmasters/Zonal Education Planning Officers and Senior Headmasters/Zonal Education Officers shall be placed in the Pay Scales as indicated against each :—

S. No.	Category	Existing Pay Scale	Upgraded Pay Scales
1.	Headmasters/Zonal Education Planning Officers.	6700-10700	8000-12950
2.	Sr. Headmasters/Zonal Education Officers.	7500-12000	8000-13500

Provided that :—

The Pay in the upgraded scale in the above cases shall be fixed in terms of Note (Pay Fixation on Upgradation of Posts) below Art. 77-B of J&K CSR inserted vide SRO-59 dated 20-03-1995 as indicated hereunder :—

- (a) In case the minimum of the upgraded pay scale is higher than the pay drawn, the pay be fixed at that minimum.
- (b) In case the pay drawn in the existing pay scale coincides with the stage of pay in the upgraded pay scale, the pay be fixed at the same stage.

- (c) In case the pay in the existing scale is drawn at a stage falling between the two stages of the pay in the upgraded pay scale, the pay be fixed at the next higher stage.
- (d) The date of increment in all the above three cases shall remain unchanged except where the pay in the pre-upgraded scale was drawn at the maximum thereof. In the later case next increment in the pay scale of the upgraded post shall be drawn after the full increment period (one year) reckoning from the date of upgradation.

This shall be deemed to have come into effect from 01-04-2005.

SRO-192.—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to section 124 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir, the Governor is pleased to direct that the following amendment shall be made in Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations :—

In the said regulations :—

I. Articles 22-D shall be recast as under :—

Art. 22-D.—

(a) Deputation :—The term “Deputations” will cover appointments made by transfer of “In-service” Government servants in public interests outside their parent organization on a temporary basis. The deputation may be from one Government Department to another of the State Government or from a Government Department (of the State) to any Corporation, Company, Autonomous Body, Public Sector Undertaking wholly owned and controlled either by the State Government or by the Central Government, or any other State Government in the country. It shall include transfers made in public interests to Municipalities, Local Bodies, Statutory Bodies, and all other Non-Government Organizations, Bodies and institutions within or outside the State.

(b) Government servants in-service who are appointed to posts outside their parent cadre on direct recruitment having competed for such appointments with other candidates whether on permanent or a temporary basis will not be regarded as on “Deputation”. Permanent transfers from one cadre/Department to another will also not be treated as deputations. Similarly Government servants who seek appointments in Public Sector Undertakings, Corporations,

Companies, etc. of their own accord, or while on deputation are absorbed permanently in such organizations and Institutions will not be treated on deputation.

- (c) Interim arrangements of posting of members of a Service in the event of conversion of a Government Office/Organizations or a portion thereof into a Public Sector Undertaking/Autonomous Body/Company/Corporations will also not be treated as deputation.

II. Article 52-B be deleted.

III. In Article 52-C :—

(a) Clause (ii) be deleted.

(b) Clause (iii) be recast as under :—

An employee appointed on deputation may elect to draw either the pay in the scale of pay of deputation position or the Basic Pay and pay scale of the parent cadre plus Personal Pay if any.

The borrowing agency should obtain the option of the employee within one month from the date of joining the deputation post unless the employee has himself/herself furnished the said option.

The option once exercised shall be final ; however, the employee may reverse his/her option under the following circumstances which shall be effective from the date of occurrence of the same :—

- (a) When he/she receives a proforma promotion or is appointed to any non-functional selection grade/any insitu promotion in his parent cadre.
- (b) When he/she is reverted to a lower grade/post/scale in his parent cadre.
- (c) When the scale of pay of the parent post on the basis of which his/her emoluments are regulated during deputation (or of the ex-cadre post) held by the employee on the deputation is either revised prospectively or from a retrospective date.

(d) If the pay scale of the employee in his cadre post undergoes a downward revision, the pay in the deputation post is automatically liable to be refixed on the basis of the revised pay and in accordance with the revised option.

Note.—The revision in the rates of DA, HRA, CCA, Monthly Medical Allowance, Ration Allowance, Washing Allowance, Non-Practicing Allowance or any other Allowances shall not be any occasion for revision of the earlier option.

Pay Fixation : When an employee on deputation elects to draw pay in the scale of pay attached to the ex-cadre post/deputation post his pay may be fixed as under :—

- (I) When the pay scale of the post in the parent cadre and that attached to the ex-cadre/deputation post are identical, the pay should be fixed at same stage and without change in the dates of increments.
- (II) When the pay scale of the post in the parent cadre and that attached to the ex-cadre/deputations are non-identical, the pay shall be fixed at the stage below the pay drawn in the cadre post and the difference be granted in the shape of personal pay to be absorbed in future increases of pay of the ex-cadre/deputation post.
- (III) When the pay scale of the post of ex-cadre/deputations is higher as compared to the cadre post in the parent Department, the pay should be fixed in terms of provisions of Note below Art. 77-B of these regulations

Note.—The pay of the officers/officials who are presently on deputation is to be fixed accordingly as per the above rules.

(f) Fixation of the pay in the case of appointments from one ex-cadre post to another ex-cadre post.

The above provisions of the rules shall apply *mutatis mutandis* in the case of appointments from one ex-cadre post to another ex-cadre post thereby fixing the pay with reference of the pay which would have

been drawn in the cadre post had he not been deputed to any ex-cadre post on deputations.

Note.—The pay of the officers/officials who are presently on deputation is to be fixed accordingly.

(c) In clause IV the portion, “after such promotion.....to drawn by him” shall be deleted.

(d) In clause V the portion “and the Deputation Allowance” shall be deleted.

(e) Clause VII shall be deleted.

IV: Article 52-⁽¹⁾ along with caption “Grant of Deputation Allowance” be deleted.

V. In Schedule XVIII of J&K Civil Service Regulations Vol-II the following amendments shall be made :—

(a) In rule 2, the last portion of first sentence reading as, “Plus a Deputation Allowance” shall be deleted and the last portion of the second sentence reading, “Without any Deputation Allowance” be deleted.

(b) In rule 13 the portion, “and 52-D” shall be deleted.
