Subject :—Implementation of Central Government decision on the recommendations of Seventh Central Pay Commission-Revision of Pension of Pre-2016 Pensioners/Family pensioners etc. AIS Officers.

Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Pension & Pensioners Welfare vide OM bearing F. N. 38/37/2016-P&PW (A) (ii) dated 4th August, 2016 has authorized revision of pension of Pre-2016 Pensioners/Family pensioners on the recommendations of Seventh Central Pay Commission. All India Service Officers have the option to either draw pension through GOI or through State Government on whose Cadre they are borne which is subsequently reimbursed by GOI. The retired AIS Officers who draw the pension through GOI have already got the benefit of pension revision on account of implementation of 7th Pay Commission recommendations but those retired officers who continue to draw pension through State Government/J&K Bank have yet to receive the benefit leading to an anomalous situation.

The issue has been examined in Finance Department and it has been decided to authorize Treasuries/Jammu & Kashmir Bank Branches to revise pension of Pre-2016 (AIS) pensioners/family pensioners in terms of reference No. 38/37/2016- P & PW (A) (ii) dated 4 August, 2016 (copy enclosed). Accordingly, following instructions are issued for revision of the pension of Pre-2016 AIS pensioners drawing pension through State Govt. Treasuries/J&K Bank branches :—

- (a) Director General Accounts & Treasuries, Finance Department shall issue instructions to all the State Government Treasuries to revise the pension of All India Service Pensioners/Family Pensioners drawing pension through State Government Treasuries interms of GOI OM referred above.

- *(b) Chairman, Jammu and Kashmir Bank shall issue similar instructions to its branches. However, the concerned branches shall be required to have the fixation of revision done through respective treasuries before authorization of same.
- (c) The concerned officers shall ensure to claim the necessary reimbursement on this account promptly from GOI.
- (d) The concerned officers shall counsel the retiring AIS Officers to opt to draw pension directly from Central Government for their convenience.

SRO-339.—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Section 124 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir, the Governor is pleased to direct that the following amendment shall be made in the Jammu and Kashmir State Insurance Fund Rules, namely :—

1. At the end of Rule-1, the following shall be added as proviso,—

“The Government Employees can take Insurance Policy up to 50 years of age instead of the Existing limit of maximum 48 years of age”.

2. State Insurance Fund Schedule of premium rates Scheme ‘B’ (Endowment Assurance) substituted vide SRO-459 dated 10-12-2010 shall be substituted by the schedule annexed to this notification.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the following amendments in the Book of Financial Powers :—

“In chapter 5.13 of the Book of Financial Powers, the Column “Nature of Powers”, “To whom delegated” and “Extent” keeping all the terms and conditions thereunder, of Serial No. 7 (i) to (vi) shall be recasted as under :—

- (a) In a situation where the lowest rates offered are not considered reasonable by the officers, he should negotiate with the lowest tenderer and allot work to him at rate considered reasonable and in case the tenderer does not reduce the rates, the next higher authority should negotiate with the next higher tenderer on the acceptance of a reasonable rate by him falling which this authority may order invitation of fresh tender. The orders of allotment of contract approved by Contract Committee should be issued by the Chief Engineer of the department to whom the work pertains. In case of allotment of contracts on negotiation basis, order for allotment should be issued by officer conducting the negotiation. In the case of allotment of contract to a contractor other than the lowest tenderer, the allotment shall be decided by the Contract Committee up to financial limit of Rs 10.00 lacs and beyond that it should be referred to Government along with recommendations of the said Committee. In case of single tender for work, the acceptance thereof shall be within the competence of the next higher authority provided the rates are considered to be reasonable by the competent authority.
- (b) If a contract duly allotted is required to be cancelled, the same be done by the next higher authority.
- (c) That the post of Chief Hospital Engineer is held by a regular deputationist Chief Engineer from PWD.
- (d) The Departmental Contract Committee for this purpose shall have the following constitution :—
1. Concerned Development Commissioner ;
 2. Chief Engineer of the concerned department ;
 3. Chief Engineer (Mech.) for such works as involve purchase of Mechanical Equipments ;
 4. Chief Engineer of Inspections, Quality control and Design ;
 5. Director Finance/Financial Advisor of the concerned department ;

6. Representative from Industries & Commerce Department, not below the rank of Additional Secretary.

(e) The next Higher authority in case of single tender cases shall be as under :—

“Note 4. In case a Government Servant or any of his/her dependant family member, undertakes treatment in a hospital listed in network of Insurance Company under Medical Insurance Scheme approved by the State Government, the expenditure admissible under rules in excess of insurance cover shall be reimbursed by treating that hospital as empaneled under J&K Civil Service (Medical Attendance-cum- Allowance) Rules, 1990 and the reimbursement shall be made at the rates as charged by such hospital.”
