SRO 398.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Jammu and Kashmir Entry Tax on Goods Act, 2000, (Act No. IV of 2000), the Government here by exempt from payment of entry tax leviable under the said Act, on the furniture/office equipment imported into the State by dealers registered under the J&K VAT Act, 2005 or J&K GST Act, 1962 as replacement for furniture/office equipment destroyed in unprecedented floods subject to submission of certificate to be prescribed by the Commissioner Commercial Taxes.

The exemption shall be available upto 31st December, 2014.
