SRO 419. — In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of section 9 of the Stamps Act, Smvt. 1977 (XL of 1977), the Government hereby directs that there shall be remission of duty chargeable under the said Act in case of instruments/documents executed between borrowers and the lending financial Institutions on the fresh loans advanced by such institutions to the persons affected by the unprecedented floods of September, 2014 for revival and rehabilitation of the fully damaged/lost infrastructure.

Provided that the District Collector concerned (Convenor, District Consultative Committee of the Banks) shall certify that the person requisitioning the fresh advance has been affected by the floods.

This notification shall come into force from 17.10.2014 and shall be valid upto one year from the date of issuance.


