## **Notification**

Srinagar, the 20th October, 2014

SRO 120.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Jammu and Kashmir Entry Tax on Goods Act, 2000, (Act No. IV of 2000), the Government hereby exempt from payment of Entry Tax, leviable under the said Act, the following goods to be imported into the State by the Chief Electoral Officer, I&K, Srinagar for their use during General Election to the J&K Legislative Assembly Elections-2014:-

S.No.	Name of the material	Quantity
1.	Ballot Units(EVM)	20000
2.	Control Units(EVM)	16000

The exemption shall be allowed subject to the condition that the Chief Electoral Officer, I&K, Srinagar shall furnish a certificate to the effect that the goods imported, are exclusively required for the aforesaid purpose.
