Jammu, the 6th April, 2015

SRO // .- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Jammu and Kashmir Entry Tax on Goods Act, 2000, the Government hereby exempt from payment of entry tax, leviable under the said Act, eighty two numbers of VSATs for computerization of Treasuries in the J&K State, to be imported into the State by the Director General, Accounts & Treasuries:

Provided that the Director General, Accounts & Treasuries certifies that the aforesaid goods are exclusively meant for computerization of Treasuries and no tax benefit percolates to the vendor.
