Srinagar, the 2nd July, 2015

SRO 208- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Jammu and Kashmir Entry Tax on Goods Act, 2000, (Act No. IV of 2000), the Government hereby exempt from payment of entry tax, leviable under the said Act, the machinery and equipment, chemicals, Reagents, Diagnostic kits, Surgical Disposables imported into the State by the Sher-i-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Soura Srinagar subject to the condition that Director, SKIMS shall issue a certificate giving full particulars of the importer/supplier, the specifications, quality of equipments/chemicals/reagents to be imported, which shall be made available, in original, to the notified Commercial Taxes Check Post, through which the import is being made and the items to be imported are exclusively meant for high end research and quality patient care.

Provided further that the Director, SKIMS certifies that no tax benefit percolates to the supplier.
