SRO 202.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Jammu and Kashmir Entry Tax on Goods Act, 2000, (Act No. IV of 2000), the Government hereby exempt from payment of entry tax, leviable under the said Act, 10 numbers of Smoke Meters provided by the Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, free of cost and imported into the State by the Motor Vehicles Department for strengthening Pollution Control Standards subject to the condition that the Transport Commissioner, J&K certifies that the equipments so imported are exclusively meant for the aforesaid purpose.
